

Directions to Pebble Cottage from the A30 (Exeter)

1. Follow the A30 past Okehampton towards Launceston. Just past Launceston filter left, heading onto the A395 towards Camelford.
2. Continue to the end of this road towards Davidstow, just after Davidstow turn left at the T junction onto the A39 towards Camelford & Wadebridge.
3. Follow the A39 through the town of Camelford, where the road narrows, then continue on to Wadebridge.
4. As you approach Wadebridge* go straight across a large roundabout, signed Wadebridge Town Centre.
5. After 400 yards, at the mini roundabout, turn right onto B3314, signposted Rock, Polzeath & Port Isaac. Pass the school and the sports centre on your left, then Wadebridge FC on your right.
6. Continue approximately 4 miles. Look for a right turn into the entrance to Treglyn Farm. The turning is directly opposite the left turn towards Trebetherick, Rock & Pityme. In essence, this forms a crossroads.
7. Follow the lane bearing right at the fork, following the white signpost to Treglyn Cottages (not Upper Treglyn). Continue to the bottom of this lane taking a sharp right and straight ahead into the car parking area. The cottages are on the left with the parking area to the right and at the bottom.
8. You will need to walk from your car round to the front of the cottages. Follow the path onto the grassland and round to the left. Pebble cottage is the 4th cottage on your left (No.5).

* Most satellite navigation kits will bring you direct to the Treglyn Farm Cottages, however, some may direct you through Chape Amble from the A39, in this instance, ignore your sat-nav and continue towards Wadebridge. Continue with directions from '5' onwards.

Enter the postcode PL27 6RG into Google Maps for visual directions.

Use Streetview to visualise the junctions.
